# Constructing a Portable Handwashing Station

Build a low-cost, portable handwashing station designed to be used anywhere on the farm that handwashing may be needed

### **KEY TERMS**

**SANITIZER**: A substance that significantly reduces the amount of microorganisms on a surface. Sanitizer will only work on surfaces that have been cleaned first. If using hand sanitizer, apply it to clean, dry nands after washing hands with soap and water.

SOAP: A cleaning product that helps to lift dirt, soil or other debris off a surface, in this case hands

# **SUPPLIES NEEDED**

- Water container with an open/close valve
- Soap dispenser
- Paper towel holder and adhesive or bungee cord
- Paper towel roll
- Dishpan or 5 gallon bucket
- Trash can or bucket with lid





# How do you do this?

Assemble the handwashing station as shown in the photo.

#### Components:

- 1. Water container with an open/close valve
  - a. Use this to hold potable water for handwashing
  - b. Warm water is ideal if you have access. The water will also warm up in the container if it's in a sunny location.
  - c. Treat the open/close valve like a sink tap: use a paper towel to turn it off after washing to avoid recontaminating hands
- 2. Soap dispenser
  - a. Soap is necessary to remove germs from hands. Water alone does not remove germs, nor does hand-sanitizer.
- 3. Paper towel holder with adhesive or bungee cord to attach to the container as shown a. Keeps paper towels in place
- 4. Dishpan or 5 gallon bucket
  - a. For collecting wastewater
- 5. Trash can or bucket with lid a. For used paper towels
